Brief Statement of Claim: Decedent killed in industrial accident. The defendant contended the decedent was barred by workers' compensation exclusion.

The plaintiff disagreed and contended that the nature of the employment was such that the decedent was employed by a general contractor.

After extensive discovery, the case was resolved prior to final trial preparation, according to the plaintiff's counsel.
